## Schera's Policy for Pet Dogs on the Patio

- You must get permission from a staff member before bringing a pet dog on the patio;
- Pet dogs shall be leashed at all times;
- Pet dogs must be controlled at all times by the dog's owner or designee;
- Pet dogs shall not enter any interior area of the food establishment at any time and must access the outdoor area via stairway alongside the patio;
- Employees are not allowed to have contact with pet dogs while on duty and cannot provide food or water dishes for the dog;
- Pet dogs are not permitted on chairs, tables, benches or seats;
- Pet dog owners must immediately notify staff in the event that excrement or bodily fluids (urine, saliva, vomit, or the like) are deposited.

These rules do not pertain to service dogs. <u>Service</u> <u>dogs, as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act</u> <u>(ADA)</u>, are already allowed in places where pet dogs (including emotional support dogs) are not.
